MEMORANDUM FOR UNDER SECRETARY OF DEFENSE FOR ACQUISITION, TECHNOLOGY, AND LOGISTICS NAVAL INSPECTOR GENERAL

SUBJECT: Audit of Navy's Single-Award Indefinite-Delivery Indefinite-Quantity Contracts (IDIQ) (Project No. D2017-D000CN-0088.000)

We plan to begin the subject audit in March 2017. Our objective is to determine whether the U.S. Navy single-award IDIQ contracts were properly justified. In addition, we will determine whether internal processes for developing, approving, and evaluating determination and finding documents are sufficient based on Federal and DoD policies. This is the third in a series of audits on single-award IDIQ contracts. We will consider suggestions from management on additional or revised objectives.

We will perform the audit at the U.S. Navy Naval Air Systems Command, Patuxent River, Maryland. We may identify additional locations during the audit.
